

## **Mandt Moment**

At LINX we are a **no touch** agency. We follow the Mandt System guidelines which promotes the graded system of alternatives. We are using philosophy and attitude, and non verbal communication all of the time. We frequently use verbal communication, and sometimes walk with or accompany individuals.

You might be confused about why we are no touch. What's the harm in a high five or a pat on the back? This is a trauma informed approach. Individuals with a trauma history may be retraumatized by touch, even when the intention of staff is good.

We ask that all visitors to LINX respect the no touch policy, so that LINX can be a place where all people feel safe.
