
Residential Program Report

Through Our Eyes

Through Our Eyes class had an opportunity to interview Lars Hansen!

Lars Hansen told us about his work. He said he liked working in Leduc because he was learning about the government and he has two jobs. When Lars was asked about his jobs, he said he's a councillor of Leduc and that he has another job in Edmonton. As a councillor he does a lot of meetings, answering phone calls, emails. One of his portfolios is the Parks and Recreation. He said that if he wanted to get a vote to change something in Leduc, he would have to get three other council members to agree. When asked how he got into politics, Lars said that he was a nerdy kid growing up and that he liked politics. He was at a debate when he was 8 years old and Bob Young was a council member. He knew then that he wanted to get into politics. Lars said that his parents were teaching and that is where he learned about the importance of public service.

When Lars was asked about having certain experience or education to be a councillor, he stated no, but what would be helpful was to have volunteered or own a business. Lars told us that he went to Leduc Estates School, the junior high, and Leduc Composite High School. He went to the University of Alberta and he graduated in 2016. Lars said that he liked his job. He said that he might want to get more education for his work. He liked that he was able to interact with people, the residents of Leduc.

Lars said that the city is growing and we'll be getting a new school. It's opening 2024 and it's called "Ohpaho" which means "taking flight". He also mentioned that Leduc was going to have a second recreation centre.

Lars told us that he likes to travel and has been to 30 different countries. Lars said that he enjoyed seeing different countries around the world. He visited France, Russia, Morocco, UK, Germany, South Africa. He talked of visiting Morocco and seeing an old castle where movies were filmed such as Indiana Jones.

Lars likes the song Thunderstruck by ACDC and the older country singers like Merle Haggard and Conway Twitty. He also mentioned that he liked songs of bird sounds and the ocean. When asked what sports he likes to play, Lars said that he enjoyed playing soccer since he was young and still plays on teams in Edmonton and Leduc. He also said that he likes to watch hockey.

Lars was asked if he could bring back a fashion trend, what would it be? He said he wanted bucket hats, and socks with Berkies because they're really comfortable.

Lars was asked that if he had a magic button on his desk and if he pressed it, it would bring him what he wanted, what did he want? He said he would like it if it brought him food. Lars said that he was a foody. He likes pizza, oysters, and other seafood.




Our “...of the month” club!
